**II. Purpose of Meeting:** The CCI-Air Working Group held a special Permit Examination meeting on Tuesday, March 5th at 5-6pm via Zoom. Georgia Pacific Gypsum has a pending permit application with NJDEP that may impact its emissions. Joann Held, Retired - NJDEP Air Quality Program, assisted residents and interested parties with understanding the application, at their request.

## III. Discussion

- DEP mailing list provides notice of permits
  - o DEP notification on the GP Gypsum permit was issued in November 2020
- GP Gypsum permit under review is for changes at facility. Includes increasing allowable emissions to some equipment but closing others for an apparent overall decrease.
- "Statement of Basis" narrative that summarizes changes they want to make; announces that permit is upf ro review and the 60-day comment period (ends May 8<sup>th</sup>)
- A public hearing could have been requested in the first 30 days
- GP Gypsum operating permit also up for renewal; hearing can be requested
- Permit is "major modification"
- 3 ways to describe particulate matter:
  - TSP all particulates including the big stuff
  - o PM 10 inhalable
  - o PM 2.5 even smaller particles
- Questions to consider:
  - Were the pieces of equipment being removed from permit in use or inactive?

- When replacing equipment with same model, has the "state-of'the art" equipment been evaluated?
- o Is there a dust management plan?
- o Are there safeguards on how all the new material will be processed?
- o Is it possible to be processing more material with less emissions?
- Does CCI know someone that is a particulate control technology contact that could assist with permit review?
